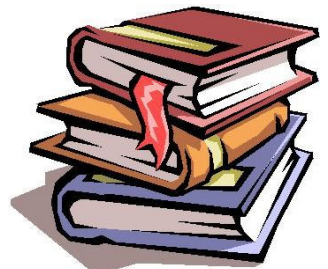

## CTK Family Rewind

Marlyss Hernandez and Jodi Von Schmidt took it upon themselves to ask local Churches if they had any "Church-stuff" that they could give us. Holy Name Church in Niceville donated the "Stations of the Cross," a lectern, the altar boy outfits, the Glory and Praise song books, three ciboriums, some purificators, altar cloths, the processional crucifix and their old organ, while Jodi Schmidt obtained many things from Corpus Christi Church in Destin. The two women also wrote letters to other Parishes asking for donations. Most of those Churches donated money so that we could purchase what we needed.

The Methodist Church in Portland donated the first two pews. More chairs were needed as the congregation began increasing. Cindy Jones and Marlyss bought the first 8 chairs and 16 more were put on layaway at Zayre's in FWB. As money became available, the chairs were finally taken out of layaway. Father Kocik, personally, gave Bob Borella \$20 to build the first altar. Marylss donated the 2 small statues and the altar drapes from her home while Herm Hernandez made the signs that were erected near the highway. After the men painted the original multicolored tin roof, Herm made a Cross to put on top of the building!
